

## THANK YOU CARD

4-1/4" x 5-1/2" (10.8 x 14 cm)

- 1. Before you start stamping, cut the following paper pieces:
  - $\bullet$  8-1/2" x 5-1/2" (21.6 x 14 cm) from Crumb Cake Cardstock
  - $\bullet$  2-1/2" x 4" (6.4 x 10.2 cm) from Basic White Cardstock
  - $\bullet$  1" x 2" (2.5 x 5.1 cm) from Soft Suede Cardstock
  - 2-1/2" x 4" (6.4 x 10.2 cm) from Symbols of Fortune Specialty Designer Series Paper.
- 2. Fold the Crumb Cake Cardstock (8-1/2"  $\times$  5-1/2"; 21.6  $\times$  14 cm) in half to create the card base.
- 3. Use the Old Olive Classic Stampin' Pad $^{\circ}$  to stamp the meadow image on one half of the Basic White Cardstock (2-1/2" x 4"; 6.4 x 10.2 cm).
- 4. Ink the deer image using the Soft Suede Classic Stampin' Pad, then stamp off some of the ink on grid paper before stamping on the Basic White Cardstock (2-1/2"  $\times$  4"; 6.4  $\times$  10.2 cm).
- 5. Die cut both stamped images.
- 6. Using the VersaMark® Pad, stamp the sentiment on Soft Suede Cardstock (1"  $\times$  2"; 2.5  $\times$  5.1 cm), then heat emboss the stamped sentiment using white Basics Embossing Powder.
- 7. Cut down the Soft Suede Cardstock (1"  $\times$  2"; 2.5  $\times$  5.1 cm) to frame the embossed sentiment.
- 8. Adhere the Symbols of Fortune Specialty Designer Series Paper  $(2-1/2" \times 4"; 6.4 \times 10.2 \text{ cm})$  to the card base, just right of center.
- 9. Adhere the meadow image near the bottom of the Symbols of Fortune Specialty Designer Series Paper (2-1/2"  $\times$  4"; 6.4  $\times$  10.2 cm) using Stampin' Dimensionals®.
- 10. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the deer image to the left side of the meadow image.
- 11. Adhere the stamped sentiment to the top right of the card.

## SEE THE GOOD CARD

5-1/2" x 4-1/4" (14 x 10.8 cm)

- 1. Before you start stamping, cut the following paper pieces:
  - $\bullet$  8-1/2" x 5-1/2" (21.6 x 14 cm) from Soft Suede Cardstock
  - 3-3/4" x 5" (9.5 x 12.7 cm) from Very Vanilla Cardstock
  - $\cdot$  2" x 2" (5.1 x 5.1 cm) from Old Olive Cardstock
  - 3/4" x 1-1/2" (1.9 x 3.8 cm) from Crumb Cake Cardstock
  - 3-3/4" x 5" (9.5 x 12.7 cm) from Symbols of Fortune Specialty Designer Series Paper
- 2. Fold the Soft Suede Cardstock (8-1/2" x 5-1/2"; 21.6 x 14 cm) in half to create the card base
- 3. Use a sponge dauber to ink the large landscape stamp with the Soft Suede Classic Stampin' Pad, then stamp the image near the bottom of the Very Vanilla Cardstock  $(3-3/4" \times 5"; 9.5 \times 12.7 \text{ cm})$ .
- 4. Adhere the stamped piece of Very Vanilla Cardstock (3-3/4"  $\times$  5"; 9.5  $\times$  12.7 cm) to the center of the card base.
- 5. Use the detailed grove die to die cut the Symbols of Fortune Specialty Designer Series Paper (3-3/4" x 5"; 9.5 x 12.7 cm).
- 6. Adhere the die-cut image over the top of the Very Vanilla Cardstock (3-3/4"  $\times$  5"; 9.5  $\times$  12.7 cm) using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals®.
- 7. Use the Soft Suede Classic Stampin' Pad to stamp the sentiment on the Crumb Cake Cardstock 3/4" x 1-1/2" ( $1.9 \times 3.8$  cm), then cut the cardstock down to size.
- 8. Die cut the detailed leaf pieces from the Old Olive Cardstock (2"  $\times$  2"; 5.1  $\times$  5.1 cm).
- Sponge the edges of the die-cut leaves using a Sponge Dauber and the Old Olive Classic Stampin' Pad, then adhere the leaves to the back of the sentiment piece.
- 10. Use Mini Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment to the card base.
